Tour the historic King Ranch, enjoy barbecue lunch at a cowboy camphouse, tour the King Ranch Museum, and shop the King Ranch Saddle Shop and Downtown Kingsville.

King Ranch, a National Historic Landmark, is recognized as the birthplace of the American ranching industry. Founded by Captain Richard King in 1853, King Ranch developed the Santa Gertrudis breed of cattle and produced the first registered Quarter Horse. Today, King Ranch sprawls across 850,000 acres of South Texas, and is the home of 60,000 cattle and 300 Quarter Horses.

## 30 October (Friday) USS LEXINGTON Evening Tour with Buffet and Bar (Limited Space) - \$48

The USS LEXINGTON, CV-16, ( the Blue Ghost) is a World War II-vintage aircraft carrier. Commissioned in 1943, she served the United States longer and set more records than any other carrier in the history of naval aviation.
